330 sailors > 3.143% ~ Pi of all

3 teams with 14 > all classes  
f165 + m165 France, Germany, Great Britain

4 nations with just 1 (one) person  
all in track & field

19 nations win 30 medals >  $(19 \cdot 100) / 65 \sim 29\%$

65 - 19 = 46 > 71% go home without any medal
